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### WELCOME

Welcome to Spotlight Productions, the resident youth theatre at Hinchingbrooke School, Huntingdon. Established 15 years ago, it is a non-profit making community based performing arts group, committed to producing outstanding musical theatre for young people in the Cambridgeshire area.

Run by a team of dedicated enthusiastic volunteers and teachers, our key aims are to encourage and nurture singing, dancing and acting talent amongst 11-28 year olds, performing much-loved musicals and demonstrating to our audiences that a West End theatre experience, can be had locally in Cambridgeshire.

While the group is non-profit making and manned entirely by volunteers, Leaders have extensive backgrounds in musical theatre. In addition, there are a large number of specialists who support the group with expertise in scenery design and construction, wardrobe, hair, make-up and child safeguarding.

The group is very fortunate to have a sponsor, Urban & Civic, which provides us with storage facilities for our 30,000+ costumes, scenery and props. We continue to look for new supporters for the group, especially those who could assist with sewing, scenery construction, painting, hair and make-up. To date, over 1600 young people have performed in our shows and our original ethos remains the same, to encourage young people from any background to take part. The group has been recognised for its support and development of young people, receiving both the Hinchingbrooke Foundation Community Award and the Huntingdon Mayor's Award for services in the community.

### DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

I truly cannot believe that it is 15 years ago since Sarah and I sat down one Sunday evening with Simon and Marion Pergande and Elena Carpenter and decided to form Spotlight Productions.

With great trepidation we sat waiting at the Performing Arts Centre to see if anyone would turn up to our first Grease workshop and 1 hour later there were over 150 excited young people sitting in the Auditorium waiting to find out more.

The rest, they say is history and 'Spotlight' has certainly moved on a pace since then, both on stage and behind the scenes. From our initial small team of helpers, we now have over 50 volunteers who give up huge amounts of time and energy to assist the group, including dedicated set builders, artists and costumiers, who work tirelessly every Saturday morning. These create our scenery and maintain costumes not only for our shows, but also those which go out on hire. Since our formation, we now have over 30,000 pieces of costume and these, together with our scenery, are hired to schools and performing arts groups all over the country to generate income for the group.

As this is our 15th anniversary we thought it only fitting to go back to the beginning of our story and once again perform the worlds best loved musical.

This time however, we have been more creative than ever to try and replicate the

film and I hope you will agree that we have 'pulled out all the stops' to make this a truly 'electrifying' production. The cast of 55 have been in rehearsal since last September and once again I cannot believe the talent and enthusiasm they have demonstrated.

So dust off your leather jackets, pull on your peddle pushers, sit back, relax and be transported back to 1959 Rydell High School, whether you're a Pink Lady or a T-bird, you're definitely the 'One that we want!'

Love is in the air for all the friends: as Doody attempts to strum a tune, he imagines his future life as a rock-n-roll star.

#### Those Magic Changes

Sandy is invited to a sleep over at Marty's house, but doesn't feel she fits in. Marty tells the girls all about her new boyfriend while Sandy hides in the bathroom.

#### Freddy My Love

Rizzo sneaks out of the house once the girls are asleep and joins the guys, who have just been introduced to Kenickie's new "hot-rod" – which isn't quite the car he'd made it out to be – not yet at least!

#### **Greased Lightnin'**

The next day, Sandy wonders if she would fit in better with the cheerleaders, led by squeaky clean Patty, but Danny turns up and there is an awkward moment of 'history' between him and Patty. Danny announces he might try out for the track team, but is it to impress Patty or Sandy?

#### Rydell Fight Song

The friends all meet up on the football field and romance blossoms between Roger and Jan.

#### Mooning

Rizzo and Kenickie start arguing. Sandy appears with the school nerd Eugene and Danny once again fails to hide his feelings for her from his friends. The school dance is the hot topic of conversation and as everyone tries to secure their date, Rizzo tells Danny she can be just like Sandy if he wants.

#### Sandra Dee

Sandy overhears the end of the song and assumes that Danny is in on the joke – disgusted with him, she storms off. Danny tries to laugh it off and Act One ends with a celebration of friendship.



### CREATIVE TEAM

### **Graham & Sarah Wilkinson**

**Artistic Director, Choreographer & Founders** 

Welcome to Spotlight Productions 17th Show. Sarah and I have both been involved in theatre for the past 36 years and whilst I predominantly 'trod the boards' and directed, Sarah, as a qualified dance teacher, specialised in ballroom, modern and theatrical dance, teaching in a number of local schools.

In September 2004, we formed our own not-for-profit performing arts group - Spotlight Productions. Since conception, we have staged 15 large-scale musicals to sell-out audiences. These include Grease (2005), A Whitechapel Tale (2006), Bugsy Malone (2006), Disco Inferno (2007), 42nd Street (2008), Back to the 80's (2009), Hairspray (2010), Fame (2011), Schools Will Rock You (2012), Some Like it Hot (2013), Les Misérables (2014), Singin' In The Rain (2015), Disco Inferno (2016), Legally Blonde (2017) and Sister Act (2018). All have received fantastic feedback. We continue to believe in our initial ethos that young people from any background should have the right to take part in our productions and hence Spotlight subscriptions remain at only £3 per week. The rest of our funding is raised through ticket sales and hiring of costumes, scenery and props.

We are fortunate to have endless support and assistance from leaders, parents, cast members and more recently local companies. Without this, the Group would never be as successful as it is and we are truly grateful.

### **Simon Jeffery**

### **Director and Stage Manager**

I have been teaching drama and performing arts to both young people and adults for the past 12 years. In 2010, I graduated with a BA Honours Degree in Drama and Theatre Studies and went on to further develop my teaching experience in Massachusetts, USA for a short time. I have now directed over 25 different productions, ranging from the classics to new originals and was delighted to join Spotlight Productions in 2013 to assist with Les Misérables. Since then I have become Grahams 'right-hand man' co-directing and stage managing the Spotlight shows. The cast has once again risen to the challenge and I can't praise them enough for the dedication and enthusiasm they have put into this year's show.

### Vicky Calver Musical Director

I originally trained in classical voice. However, I quickly discovered a love of musical direction, conducting (possibly borne out of my uncontrollable need to be in charge) and musical theatre. Following my passion, I built up the highly-acclaimed choir 'Out of the Shadows' while musical directing for many professional and amateur companies across the country. I am now settled in London and love my eclectic work of teaching voice, conducting and directing. Having now been with Spotlight for 3 years, I am definitely part of the 'family'.

# **Georgie Smit Vocal Coach**

I was thrilled to join Spotlight for last years production of Sister Act as their resident vocal coach. I have over 16 years experience as a vocal tutor, teaching a wide range of repertoire from musical theatre, jazz, pop, through to classical music. I am also an active gigging singer, performing with various bands, including a close harmony vocal trio with the M.D. Vicky Calver, as well as performing regularly throughout East Anglia as a singer pianist. In addition to my professional work, I also enjoy participating in amateur theatre. I have once again thoroughly enjoyed working with the Spotlight team. Rehearsals have been a lot of fun and I am so impressed with the standard of singing and performing. I have really been made to feel 'part of the family' and am very much looking forward to working with Spotlight again in our next production.

### Will Swepstone

### Sound Technician and Lighting Design

I am currently in my final year of A-Level's studying Maths, Further Maths, Physics and Design & Technology, I have been working with Spotlight, behind the scenes, since I was 9 and can be found at Spotlight's storage unit in Alconbury on a Saturday morning, building scenery and props. In 2014, I started attending the weekly rehearsals, running sound and learning the technical side of the shows. Since then I have assisted with lighting during Singin' in the Rain, operated the 'light-up' Saturday Night Fever dance floor for Disco Inferno and run 'sound' for Legally Blonde and Sister Act. This year I have managed to acquire many additional duties and skills within my Spotlight role, including managing the on-line ticket system, producing this programme, managing the website and creating the lighting design for this production. I would also like to thank Richard Newlove at Amina Technologies for giving me the opportunity of being trained to operate the CNC router, which has enabled me to produce large and small scale intricate pieces of scenery, that are normally only seen when visiting West End theatres.

During show week, you will find me up 'in the box' programming the lighting cues and running the radio mics and sound desk. This is something I would definitely like to pursue as a career once I finish my A-levels this year.

### **Nan Wolfenden**

### **Choreographers Assistant and Chaperone**

As a fitness instructor for over 20 years, I joined the group back in 2010 with a wealth of experience. As the groups Choreographers Assistant, my main task is to work with the performers, ensuring that they are all fully proficient in the dance routines. Often acting as a dance partner, I demonstrate steps and later polish the numbers to make sure that everything looks amazing for show week. In addition, I assist with the group's administration and I am a member of our child safeguarding team.

### Melissa Wilson Head of Wardrobe, Costumier and Chaperone

I joined the group alongside my two children in 2011 and currently create and maintain our extensive collection of costumes. On a Saturday morning you will find me at our storage unit, checking and preparing costumes for hires and ensuring that everything is in order. In addition to my sewing duties, in 2017 I also took over the role of Wardrobe Mistress, running our team of 'Dressing Room' volunteers during show week and ensuring that every piece of costume that goes on stage looks fabulous and fits perfectly. I am also one of the groups qualified chaperones. In addition to the Grease costumes, this year I have been responsible for creating some unique headwear! I can't wait to see the finished result.

### Angela Black Child Safeguarding Officer

I am an Ofsted-registered childminder and hold a Cambridgeshire County Council Chaperone Licence. I have been working with children for the past 28 years and the last 9 years with Spotlight. I really enjoy the performing arts and watching the young people fulfil their dreams and grow in confidence within our friendly group. Managing the group's 20 chaperones, I will be behind the scenes ensuring that our cast are safe and happy throughout the show's run.

### **Mark Harrington**

### **Scenic Construction and Front of House**

Spotlight, for me, began 7 years ago as a taxi driver for Rebecca in her first show. Like everyone else who has ever met Sarah and Graham, I was soon part of the Spotlight team, working "Front of House" selling programmes and raffle tickets. Since then, my role within the group has developed extensively and I can now be found every Saturday morning building and maintaining the groups scenery.

### Paul Swepstone

### **Scenic Design and Construction**

Life has not been the same for me since I moved into the house next door to Graham and Sarah, 9 years ago and I was quickly recruited into the Spotlight team. Apparently my expertise in creating bespoke set pieces has been invaluable when producing the scenery for Sister Act and Grease!

# **Kevin Williams Scenic Construction**

Now in my 10th year with Spotlight. Probably my biggest project was building the full Les Misérables set and the most fun was creating the Schools Will Rock You campervan from scratch. My favourite bit is, without a doubt, show week, which I always look forward to. From the moment the team get in to build the set, to when they are crashing it again a week later, until silly o'clock in the morning, I have an amazing time. I love the buzz of everyone working together and having a good time, whilst putting on an awesome show!
