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# WELCOME

Welcome to Spotlight Productions, the resident youth theatre at Hinchingbrooke School, Huntingdon. Established 19 years ago, it is a non-profit making community based performing arts group, committed to producing outstanding musical theatre for young people in the Cambridgeshire area.

Run by a team of dedicated enthusiastic volunteers and teachers, our key aims are to encourage and nurture singing, dancing and acting talent amongst 11-28 year olds, performing much-loved musicals and demonstrating to our audiences that a West End theatre experience, can be had locally in Cambridgeshire.

While the group is non-profit making and manned entirely by volunteers, leaders have extensive backgrounds in musical theatre. In addition, there are a large number of specialists who support the group with expertise in scenery design and construction, wardrobe, hair, make-up and child safeguarding.

We continue to look for new supporters for the group, especially those who can assist with sewing, scenery construction, painting, hair and make-up. To date, over 1,700 young people have performed in our shows and our original ethos remains the same, to encourage young people from any background to take part. The group has been recognised for its support and development of young people, receiving both the Hinchingbrooke Foundation Community Award and the Huntingdon Mayor's Award for services in the community.

# **DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE**



Who would have thought that so much could change in 12 months. Unfortunately, in July our sponsor, Urban & Civic, who had supported us for many years with storage premisses at Alconbury Weald, advised us that we had to vacate our Aircraft Hangar by January 2023, as the site was scheduled for redevelopment for new housing.

With over 35,000 costumes plus scenery & props to store, we knew we were in trouble, as without these items to hire out, we were unable to generate the required income to keep the group 'afloat'. For the months following, we enquired constantly to try and find a new storage facility for the group, with no success. At this point, closure looked inevitable...

However, sometimes you need a little luck and that came in the form of Russell Payne, who had 2 'Nissen Huts' and storage containers available to rent at the old RAF Upwood site and so we finally had a new home.

The move was truly impressive and included two 40 Tonne lorries, two Luton vans and 30 people, over three weekends (More on this later on in the programme). It would be remiss of me not to say a huge thank you to all of my team and 'Pingall Transport', for their time and hard work in making the move possible.

Alongside this, work commenced on our 20th show which like the move had its challenges. So, we spent the summer months teaching all the cast how to tap dance and I am sure you will agree how well they have done. Without a doubt the show has been one of the most difficult to stage, with huge scenery, fantastic costumes and demanding dance routines, but as ever the cast & crew's commitment and enthusiasm have been amazing.

So, sit back and join the cast on the 'SS American' as they take you on a voyage filled with songs, dance and laughter.

# SYNOPSIS

#### Act I

In a New York City bar in the early 1930s, successful Wall Street banker Elisha Whitney waits impatiently for his assistant, Billy Crocker. Billy drops off some items for Whitney's upcoming vacation, but forgets Whitney's passport. Billy agrees to deliver it on the cruise ship the following morning. As Whitney exits, Billy's old friend Reno Sweeney arrives. A sexy Evangelist turned nightclub singer, Reno plans to travel on the same boat as Whitney. Reno is quite fond of Billy ("I Get A Kick Out Of You"), but Billy is in love with a girl named Hope Harcourt.

The next morning, The SS American is set to sail ("There's No Cure Like Travel"). The ship's passengers include: American debutante Hope Harcourt; her wealthy English fiancé Lord Evelyn Oakleigh; Hope's widowed mother, Evangeline Harcourt; Minister Henry T. Dobson and his two recent converts, a pair of rascally street toughs named Spit and Dippy; Reno Sweeney and her six showgirl Angels; and gangster (and Public Enemy Number 13) Moonface Martin, disguised as a minister, with his accomplice Erma. When Billy boards the ship, Whitney tells him to sell all shares of Amalgamated stock. But Billy is distracted when he discovers that Hope is sailing with her fiancé. He inadvertently identifies Minister Dobson as Moonface Martin, so two F.B.I. agents throw the minister in the ship's brig, leaving Spit and Dippy – who turn out to be skilled pickpockets – to wander the ship without supervision.

Moonface and Erma thank Billy by offering him the unused ticket of their friend, Snake Eyes Johnson, who is wanted by the FBI as Public Enemy Number 1. Billy, determined to win Hope's heart, accepts the ticket just as the ship sets off ("Bon Voyage/There's No Cure Like Travel"). Reno agrees to help Billy, but first she has to boost his confidence ("You're The Top"). While Evelyn nurses a bout of seasickness, Billy spends some time alone with Hope ("Easy To Love"), but she feels obligated to marry Evelyn. Meanwhile, Whitney, an old Yale man, unsuccessfully attempts to woo Evangeline ("The Crew Song").

Moonface and Erma come clean to Billy and they help disguise him as a sailor ("There'll Always Be A Lady Fair"). While Billy masquerades as a sailor, Spit and Dippy make a killing by expertly playing cards, picking pockets and shooting craps. Moon and Reno come up with a plan for Reno to seduce Evelyn and break off his engagement to Hope ("Friendship"). Though the plan fails, Reno develops a genuine romantic interest in Evelyn.

While donning crazy disguises, Billy and Moon tell Evangeline that Evelyn is insane, but Hope reveals Billy's true identity. Hope is distraught by Billy's antics, but with Reno's encouragement – she warms to his advances ("It's De-lovely"). The Purser finally catches Billy and arrests him for being Snake Eyes Johnson, Public Enemy Number 1. The captain and passengers are thrilled to have a celebrity onboard however, and they all rejoice ("Anything Goes").

#### Act II

Billy and Moon continue to receive star treatment ("Public Enemy Number 1"). Reno and her Angels lead a nightclub act that is part entertainment, part religious revival. Several passengers confess to immoral behavior in the past: Evelyn confesses to a youthful tryst with a young Hollywood actress who was playing Anne Boleyn and Billy apologises to Hope, admitting his deceit. Reno leads a rousing musical celebration ("Blow, Gabriel, Blow"), but the passengers are outraged that Billy is no celebrity, so Billy and Moon are sent to the ship's brig. Evangeline announces that Hope and Evelyn will be married in the morning and Hope is devastated ("Goodbye, Little Dream, Goodbye").

In jail, Moon tries to cheer Billy up ("Be Like The Blue Bird") and Billy receives a love note from Hope ("All Through The Night"). Meanwhile on deck, Evelyn realises he's in love with Reno ("The Gypsy in Me"). Spit and Dippy are jailed for gambling onboard. Reno visits the jail and updates Billy and Moon. Spit reveals that he picked the Purser's pocket, acquiring the jail cell keys. Before they escape, Spit and Dippy change clothes with Billy and Moon so everyone will be harder to detect. Meanwhile, on deck, Erma entertains a group of sailors ("Buddie, Beware").

The wedding begins, but it's soon interrupted by Billy and Moon, along with Reno, disguised as "Anne Boleyn." The three impostors manage to cancel the wedding and soon Hope and Billy end up together, as do Reno and Evelyn and Evangeline and Whitney. Billy confesses that he never sold the shares of Amalgamated stock, but a telegram arrives saying that Amalgamated stock has gone through the roof and Whitney is richer than ever! As the captain officiates a triple wedding, the entire company celebrates (Finale: "It's De-lovely").


We were, however, fortunate to finally find a new 'home' at RAF Upwood which has enabled the group to continue.

# **CREATIVE TEAM**

## Graham & Sarah Wilkinson - Artistic Director, Producer & Founders -

We cannot believe that "Anything Goes" is our 20th show and it still gives us the same thrill as when we first started. Whilst modern theatre has changed, we still believe that audiences should experience shows with outstanding scenery and costumes, delivered by enthusiastic and talented young people.

Both of us have a wealth of theatrical experience, Graham, 'treading the boards' and directing theatre with a number of companies and Sarah, as a qualified dance teacher and choreographer.

Our enforced break due to Covid-19 made us even more determined to carry on bringing quality musical theatre to Huntingdon and we delivered a 'Magic of the Musicals' homage to the best musical shows, followed by 'Oliver!' in April 2022.

Our ethos of welcoming any young person wishing to perform will continue, which is why no one has to audition to join the group and subs remain at £3 per week for the cast. Spotlight is a "family" and without the commitment of numerous volunteers in various roles both on and off stage, we would never have been as successful as we are, truely grateful is not enough!

#### **Will Swepstone**

- Technical Director/Scenic Design & Construction -

With another show 'sailing around the corner', I am pleased to say that this is my 13th year with Spotlight.

My roles within the group have been extremely varied, originally starting out behind the scenes, I took on the official Technician role in 2014 and in 2019 became Technical

During the early years, I assisted with lighting for "Singin' in the Rain", controlled an LED light-up dance floor for "Disco Inferno" (Something I would not volunteer to do again in a hurry....) and setup/ran sound for "Legally Blonde", "Sister Act" and "Grease". In 2021/22, I designed and constructed the scenery for both our Christmas show, "Magic of the Musicals", which was our 1st show post Covid-19 and "Oliver! the Musical" last April.

A big part of my role during the year is designing and constructing the scenery for our annual large-scale Musical. This year has been particularly exciting, as I was tasked with building 'the boat' for "Anything Goes", a project that must be my biggest to date.

In 'real-life', I am currently the Operations Manager/Project Manager for Amina Technologies Ltd, the worlds leading 'Invisible Loudspeaker' manufacturer. Starting out as a Technician with the company back in 2019, I have been able to develop my CAD skills and learn how to program and operate the company's CNC router. Without these skills and Amina's support in allowing me to use their facilities 'out of hours', I would not be able to create the 'stunning' set pieces that have been on stage tonight!

As we say, 'Bon Voyage' to "Anything Goes", myself and the rest of the scenic construction team have the exciting task next of building the interior of the "The Addams Family" mansion, something we are very much looking forward to, without giving 'Full Disclosure', it's going to be epic!

#### Simon Jeffery - Director -

2023 marks my 10th Year Anniversary with Spotlight Productions and what a decade it has been. I started my life in theatre, being a student of a local youth group when I was 12 and started teaching my first class at the age of 16. After graduating with a BA Honours Degree in Drama and Theatre Studies with a specific focus on teaching young adults, I continued to develop my teaching skills for a short time in Massachusetts, USA before returning to the UK to continue teaching and coaching.
