Established 21 years ago, Spotlight Productions is a non-profit making community based performing arts group, committed to producing outstanding musical theatre for young people in the Cambridgeshire area.

Run by a team of dedicated enthusiastic volunteers, our key aims are to encourage and nurture singing, dancing and acting talent amongst 11-30 year olds, performing muchloved musicals and demonstrating to our audiences that a West End theatre experience, can be had locally in Cambridgeshire.

While the group is non-profit making and manned entirely by volunteers, leaders have extensive backgrounds in musical theatre. In addition, there are a large number of specialists who support the group with expertise in scenery design and construction, wardrobe, hair, make-up and child safeguarding.

We continue to look for new supporters for the group, especially those who can assist with sewing, scenery construction, painting, hair and make-up. To date, over 1,800 young people have performed in our shows and our original ethos remains the same, to encourage young people from any background to take part.

The group has been recognised for its support and development of young people, receiving both the Hinchingbrooke Foundation Community Award and the Huntingdon Mayor's Award for outstanding musical theatre.

SYNOPSIS

Based on the smash hit 1991 Disney animated feature and dating back to a late 18thcentury classic French fairy tale, Beauty and the Beast tells the story of Belle, a beautiful and intelligent young woman who feels out of place in her provincial French village. When her father is imprisoned in a mysterious castle, Belle's attempt to rescue him leads to her capture by the Beast, a grisly and fearsome monster, who was long ago trapped in his gruesome form by an enchantress. The only way for the Beast to become human once again is if he learns to love and be loved in return. There is a time limit, too: once a magical rose loses all of its petals, all hope will be lost and he will stay a Beast forever. The Beast's enchanted household - populated by such beloved characters as Mrs Potts, Lumiere, Cogsworth, and Chip - watch anxiously as Belle and the Beast grow to understand and befriend one another. Their feelings grow ever deeper as the clock ticks and petals continue to fall off the rose... will they confess their love for one another before it is too late?



CREATIVE TEAM

Graham & Sarah Wilkinson

- Artistic Director, Producer & Founders -

Welcome to Spotlight's 21st show and we are very excited to perform "Beauty and the Beast".

This story has been immortalised in many different ways, and we have worked very hard to make it as close to the original as possible. Therefore, this year we have hired in professional scenery and costumes to complement our enthusiastic and talented cast.

If you read some of the other Creative Team write-ups, you will see that we are so lucky to have such a wealth of experience in all aspects of Musical Theatre.

Our ethos of welcoming any young person to the group remains, which is why we keep our subs at £3 per week and ask no one to audition to be in the show.

The 'Spotlight Family' continues to grow and long may this continue.

Will Swepstone

- Technical Director/Scenic Design & Construction -

This year marks 15 years since I first joined Spotlight, and it has been another fantastic year!

During my time with the group, I have taken on numerous roles. Originally starting out behind the scenes, I officially became a 'Technician' in 2014 before stepping into my current role as 'Technical Director' in 2019.

Over the years, I have had the opportunity to be involved in various technical aspects of our productions—from operating the follow spot for "Singin' in the Rain" to controlling an LED light-up dance floor for "Disco Inferno" (something I wouldn't volunteer to do again in a hurry...). Since "Legally Blonde" in 2017, I have been responsible for setting up and running sound for all of Spotlight's shows, in addition to designing and programming the lighting.

In 2021, the group relaunched following the COVID-19 pandemic with a musical medley, "Magic of the Musicals". For this show, I designed and built a log cabin, marking the start of my scenic design and construction journey with Spotlight. Since then, our sets have grown bigger and better—from the streets of London for "Oliver!" to embarking on the maiden voyage of the SS American, where we built an ocean liner for our production of "Anything Goes". My biggest project to date has been constructing the entirety of "The Addams Family" mansion for last year's show.

Back in the 'real world', I work as the 'Operations Manager/Project Manager' for Amina Technologies Ltd, the world's leading designer and manufacturer of 'Invisible Loudspeakers'. I joined the company in 2019 as a 'Technician' and have since expanded my skill set, allowing me to progress into a more senior position. Amina's support in my professional development, as well as access to their CNC router facilities out of hours, has enabled me to be more creative with scenic design—allowing me to build bespoke set pieces typically only seen in professional productions.

This year, the entire scenic team and I have taken a break from major musical set construction, as we hired professional scenery for our production of "Beauty and the Beast". This has allowed us to focus on maintaining the group's extensive hire stock while also taking the opportunity to upgrade some key set pieces.

Simon Jeffery

- Director

I am once again thrilled to be a member of the 'Creative Team' for this year's major musical, "Beauty and the Beast".

Having started out in theatre at the age of 12 as a student of a local youth group, I progressed to teaching my first class when I was 16. After graduating with a BA Honours Degree in Drama and Theatre Studies with a specific focus on teaching young adults, I continued to develop my directing skills for a short time in Massachusetts, USA before returning to the UK to resume teaching and coaching drama.

I have been involved in both amateur and professional theatre productions, which span over 37 different shows of many genres.

After Joining Spotlight in 2013, I can certainly say that I, amongst many others, have found a home in this ever-growing community of talented young people, that I am proud and privileged to be a part of.

Once again, this year's cast has blown me away with their dedication, talent and professionalism, in what will be another spectacular show!

To enable Spotlight to deliver outstanding productions every year, the group has to generate a substantial amount of additional income.
